High Risk Health Conditions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Obesity (BMI&gt;40)</li> <li>• other treatments causing immunosuppression</li> <li>• intellectual or developmental disabilities</li> <li>• one essential caregiver for someone with any of these conditions</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Hospital Immunization Clinics</a>
Highest Risk Health Conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• had an organ transplant anytime in the past</li> <li>• had a stem cell transplant (bone marrow transplant) any time in the past</li> <li>• have a neurological disease that makes it difficult to breathe (for example, motor neuron disease, myasthenia gravis, multiple sclerosis</li> <li>• were diagnosed with cancer that affects your blood, bone marrow or lymph nodes (a haematological malignancy) within the last year</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Hospital Immunization Clinics</a>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• have severe kidney disease (eGFR under 30)</li> <li>• are an essential caregiver for someone with any of these conditions</li> </ul>

Residents, staff and essential caregivers in high-risk congregate settings	Vaccines will be arranged at the facilities
